What problems are security forces facing and how can they be solved?

Achievements

Know-how on the management of an online community of LEAs

The project has highlighted the key principles for a good management of an online participatory platform for LEAs, ranging from administrative support for members to the testing of new facilitation tools.

Identifying the needs for standardisation

Through a series of questionnaires, the team has studied the LEAs' needs for standardisation be it in terms of their involvement in R&D project or in terms of their operational needs.

Providing new ideas or channeling existing solutions

*Several meetings were organised to present innovative tools to LEAs which answer identified challenges in the areas of the fight against **terrorism**, the fight against **illegal migration**, **cybercrime** and **serious and organised crime**.
Two sub-contracted studies have been conducted on the theme of information sharing between LEAs and on the theme of age determination in a migratory context.*
